participants are eligible for prizes.



Babies, Toddlers, and Tots

Early Literacy for ages 3 and under, plus a caregiver!



(birth - 18 mo. and a caregiver)

Tuesdays, 10:00-10:45 am -Ms. Neena, Main Library Young babies benefit from story time, singing, bouncing and dancing, and socialization. This is our regularly scheduled nine week program for our youngest patrons.

<u>Toddlers in Training</u> (18-30 mo. and a caregiver) Fridays, 10:00-10:45 am -Ms. Neena, Main Library

Does your baby love to bounce and play? Join Ms. Neena every Friday for an educational story, singing, and rhyming sure to get baby giggling. Ends with social play.



<u>Twoodalo Twos!</u> (2.5-3.5 years and a caregiver) Fridays 11:00 -11:45 am -Ms. Neena, Main Library

This program incorporates sensory, art, storytelling, music, and movement all in one to prepare tots to read, write, and think critically.

Rookie Readers

(Prereaders, ages 4-6)

Session I: 2:00 - 2:30 pm Session II: 2:45 - 3:15 pm

Rookie Readers is a one-to-one literacy builder. It pairs a child_listener, ages 4-6, with a school-aged reading buddy. The older child reads, modeling, reading to and talking about great stories with the younger. The program is meant to increase student fluency, reading with expression, and reading confidence.

These partnerships increase prereaders' interest in reading and encourage positive communication and comprehension.

Rookie Readers

(Readers, Grades 3-5)

Session I: 2:00 — 2:30 pm Session II: 2:45 — 3:15 pm

Rookie Readers is a one-to-one literacy builder designed for students who are proficient, independent readers entering grades 3 – 5. It pairs each reader with a child listener, ages 4-6. Readers are responsible for reading to their partner and talking about great stories! The program is meant to increase student fluency, reading with expression, and reading confidence. They also provide great role models for our young listeners.

Book Buddies (Grades 1-3)

Session I: 4:00 – 4:30 pm Session II: 4:45 – 5:15 pm

Book Buddies is one-on-one reading practice for new, reluctant, & struggling readers entering grades 1-3. We pair school-age readers with teen volunteers trained to help them with their literacy skills. Teens and children both rave about the relationships they've made with their buddies, and the program is designed to increase student fluency, reading with expression, and reading confidence, too!
